- 2. To what extent should we be concerned as a society that automation will lead to job losses?
- 3. What ethical boundaries, if any, should there be on a person using aggressive measures in response to being hacked (i.e. "hacking back")?
- 4. The Free Software Movement argues that licenses are unethical. Are they correct? Why or why not?
